ADDENDUM 1: CLARIFICATION


RE: RE: TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF ASSORTED PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (RESERVED FOR YOUTH, WOMEN & PWD'S) (RE-TENDER) TENDER NO. GDC/SHE/OT/061/2022-2023.

In response to bidder's request for clarification, GDC wishes to provide the following response;

S.N	BIDDER'S QUERY	GDC'S RESPONSE
1.	Are bidders in the category, let's say Youth, allowed to choose a schedule to bid for or they must submit bids for all schedules?	Bidders can choose one ore more scheduled in the category which they qualify. It is not mandatory to quote for all scheduled in your category
2.	Does sole proprietorship companies need to provide power of Attorney nominating a person to transact on behalf of the company?	All bidders are required to provide a Power of Attorney witnessed by an advocate indicating that the tender has been dully signed by the person lawfully authorized to do so as stipulated in part 8 of mandatory evaluation criteria.
3.	Page 30 of the document, "Requirement no 5" I quote " The bidders must provide evidence of having supplied personal protective equipment (indicate client/company, items supplied, value of items and the year of supply). i.e. Provide Recommendation letters (3 in No.) or LPO copies (3 in No.) to support the experience. ". So what happens to AGPO New Companies that are willing to participate in the Tender but do not have any evidence of having supplied PPE's?	This requirement remains since it has been met by AGPO participants who have previously been awarded tenders for supply of PPE

NB: All other instructions remain unchanged.
