ADDENDUM 1 – CLARIFICATION & EXTENSION OF CLOSING DATE

RE: ESTABLISHMENT OF DIRECT-USE APPLICATIONS FROM GEOTHERMAL BRINE IN MENENGAI/BARINGO-SILALI GEOTHERMAL FIELD.- GDC/BD/RU/RFP/002/2025-2026

In response to your request for clarification & extension of the closing date, GDC wishes to respond as follows;

S.N	INVESTORS' QUESTIONS	GDC CLARIFICATIONS
1.	Whether both Tender Ref: GDC/BD/RU/EOI/001/2025-2026 and Tender Ref: GDC/BD/RU/RFP/002/2025-2026 can bid individually, or Whether participation in both tenders is mandatory by a single bidder.	Participation in both EOI for Geothermal Spa Complex and RFP for Direct Use Applications is not mandatory, and interested Investors are free to choose the category that best aligns with their interests and capabilities.
2.	Page 7 (7. Information Sheet), we have seen tariff for Brine at 0.766 USD/ton. We find that the tariff is high, could you kindly clarify us on the tariff and reference of calculation	GDC's approved Brine tariff is 0.0123 USD/kW which is 0.766 USD/ton equivalent. This is as per GDC's energy tariff model, currently applicable as the reference tariff. This is comparatively lower than the current Steam tariff. Investors are urged to use the published tariff as the reference for submissions at this stage.
4.	To better prepare our bid, kindly share with us the full water composition, including lithium concentration of the brine to be provided by GDC.	Interested investors are advised to include in their bids where possible, their full water composition requirements to allow GDC best evaluate their bids.

5.	Is the tender only for Menengai and/or Silali only?	Yes. The advert limits the scope to geothermal resources available in both the Menengai Geothermal Field, and the Baringo–Silali Block.
6.	Can one give a proposal for using the brine at KenGen Olkaria?	No. The scope of this advert is confined to geothermal resources under GDC’s mandate, specifically the Menengai, and Baringo–Silali Geothermal Fields.
7.	Do you have documents/information that can be shared to show the studies of brine content/ concentrations at Menengai and Silali?	At this stage, interested investors are encouraged to prepare their submissions based on the information provided in the EOI/RFP requirements. Upon successful consideration, GDC shall share brine mineralogy with potential investors
8.	We request for additional time to enable us to finalize and submit our proposal	The submission is hereby extended from 24th June 2026 to Wednesday 8th July 2026 at 2.00Pm.
